WHEREAS the Commission has received a request from the Peninsula Public Library for certification of eligible names for the title of Administrative Assistant I, and

WHEREAS there is no eligible list in existence at this time for the Peninsula Public Library but there is a list, Administrative Assistant, Bilingual (Spanish) established for Nassau County Departments, and

WHEREAS the specifications for Administrative Assistant I and Administrative Assistant, Bilingual (Spanish) are comparable,

RESOLVED, That the Executive Director is to forward to the Peninsula Public Library eligible list No. 68-935, Administrative Assistant, Bilingual (Spanish) to fill the position of Clerk-Typist I/Typist-Clerk, in conformance with Rule 16(1) of the Rules of this Commission.
