## IN THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS (placed on hold at the December 2, 2021 Hearing) ADD:

Ø Assistant to Commissioner (Public Works)

RULE XI Section 2:

### DELETE:

2. Applicants for competitive examination shall be given notice of the disposition of their applications at least four days before the examination, by mail to the address stated in the application, or one day's notice by telegram

### ADD:

2. Applicants for competitive examination shall be given notice of the disposition of their applications at least four days before the examination, by mail to the address stated in the application, or one day's notice <u>by electronic</u> <u>correspondence</u>

### RULE XIV

ADD:

4. <u>Whenever a vacancy exists in a position in the competitive class and an</u> <u>open-competitive examination duly advertised results in three or fewer</u> <u>approved applicants, and the announced minimum qualifications for the position</u> <u>included a requirement of possession of a license or certificate in a profession</u> <u>issued by the State of New York, the Commission may waive the examination</u> <u>and certify for appointment to the appointing authority the names of such</u> <u>qualified applicants, provided, however, that such applicants have been licensed</u> or certified in the profession by the State of New York.

#### RULE XVI Section 3:

#### DELETE:

3. When an eligible is canvassed for appointment or is offered appointment in writing and fails to state his willingness to accept such appointment within seven working days after the mailing of such canvass or offer, or before the end of the next succeeding working day if such canvass or offer is sent by telegram, he may be considered ineligible for purposes of making selection for such particular appointment.

### ADD:

3. When an eligible is canvassed for appointment or is offered appointment in writing and fails to state his willingness to accept such appointment within seven working days after the mailing of such canvass or offer, or before the end of the next succeeding working day if such canvass or offer is sent <u>by electronic correspondence</u> he may be considered ineligible for purposes of making selection for such particular appointment.

### **RULE XIX Section 7:**

#### DELETE:

7. Restoration to Eligible List

A probationer whose employment is terminated or who resigns before the end of his probationary term may request that his name be restored to the eligible list from which he was appointed, provided such list is still in existence. His name may be restored to such list if the Commission in its discretion determines that the probationer should be given <del>a second</del> opportunity for appointment.

### ADD:

7. Restoration to Eligible List

A probationer whose employment is terminated or who resigns before the end of his probationary term may request that his name be restored to the eligible list from which he was appointed, provided such list is still in existence. His name may be restored to such list if the Commission in its discretion determines that the probationer should be given <u>another</u> opportunity for appointment.

RESOLVED, That upon approval of the State Civil Service Commission the title shall be listed in Appendix B Non-Competitive positions County Service of the Rules of this Commission and the appropriate identifying symbol shall be used, and be it further
