076/2023 -- A motion was made by Commissioner Foskey, seconded by Commissioner DeLuca and unanimously carried adopting the following resolution:

WHEREAS the specifications for Purchasing Agent and Technical Coordinator I, Purchase/Purchasing Agent are comparable,
