113/2021 -- A motion was made by Commissioner Markowitz, seconded by Commissioner DeLuca and unanimously carried adopting the following resolution:

WHEREAS the Commission has received a request from the Hicksville Public School and the Village of Hempstead for certification of eligible names for the title of Administrative Assistant I, and

WHEREAS there is no eligible list in existence at this time for the Hicksville Public School and the Village of Hempstead but there is a list, Administrative Assistant, Bilingual (Spanish) established for Nassau County Departments,

WHEREAS the specifications for Administrative Assistant I and Administrative Assistant, Bilingual (Spanish) are comparable,

RESOLVED, That the Executive Director is to forward to the Hicksville Public School and the Village of Hempstead eligible list No. 68-935 Administrative Assistant, Bilingual (Spanish) to fill the position of Administrative Assistant I in conformance with Rule 16(1) of the Rules of this Commission.
